The collection portal was closed April 14, 2025, 10.5% response rate. Survey question responses were briefly reviewed. Data analysis will begin shortly; data was collected through the IDFPR licensing system. Demand data: currently working with Illinois Department of Employment Service/IDES with data that they are able to obtain through their contract with LightCast. Data collection to include the National Forum of State nursing Workforce Centers (Forum) Minimum Data Set (MDS) for demand data. If a nurse has a joint appointment they may be, for example, counted as faculty or as staff. At the next Workforce Center meeting will need to review recently updated Forum supply minimum data set revisions and questions for the next surveys to be voluntarily be collected during license renewal beginning in 2026.
